

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Investigating the reductive form and performative experience of mid-century minimalism, Forbes's neo-minimalist language retains traditional tenets while leveraging their symbolic communicative potential.

Influences are evident: the imperative black and white palette, enlarged mass, negative release, repetition, and pattern recognition, each occupying timed tension in an essentialized language of abstract form. However, at this point, the narrative moves beyond physical experience into the conceptual space.



Following the prescient black & white realizations of his 2020 series 'Minimalism Redefined,' neoworks incorporate the use of specified color in their telling. The tonal

dialogue, while familiar, invokes a novel aspect, bringing understatement to work that defines itself through forthrightness.





Tim Forbes bases his international art practice on the secluded South Shore of Nova Scotia on the Ancestral Territory of the Mi'kmaq people. Preoccupied with the potential for meaning in material form, and the encoding of communication, Forbes employs techniques of translation, pattern recognition and repetition to enlist the minimal in the service of commentary.

Attuned to perceptual shifts that arise in relation to different material languages, Forbes investigates the mediums of photography, sculpture, and painting. In his exploration of inhabited bodily space, his sculpture delves into haptic acuity. In his photography, he examines states of nature, cultural memory, and architecture without architects. His neo-minimalist paintings explore nuance to connote meaning through elements of black, white, colour, scale, line and relational mass.
